The AACEAINC Community Service Scholarship has been designated for a graduating high school senior of New York State who has performed 300 to 500 community service hours and is of African-American or Caribbean heritage. This award shall range from \$500 to \$1000 depending on applicant's documentation, interview, and letters of recommendation validating service. Applicant must be accepted to attend a four-year college or university in the Fall 2018.

Eligibility

High School Applicant Criteria:

- Resident and High School Student of New York State
- Performed a minimum of 300 to 500 community service hours during the course of high school tenure
- High school grade point average of 80 or higher
- Show proof of having taken the SAT or ACT
- Copy of Acceptance Letter to Four Year College or University for Fall 2018
- Submission of 250 Word Essay Entitled:
"Community Service Helps the Community to Succeed, Builds Character, and Commands Leadership"
The following criteria is to be clearly stated in essay:
 - 1) What compelled you to give service?
 - 2) What was a high point? Share an example or anecdote
 - 3) How has the experience made a difference for you and/or someone you helped?
- **If selected for interview, bring to Interview copy of Social Security Card and Birth Certificate**
- **Must graduate high school**
- **Must attend Scholarship Dinner Award Ceremony August 2, 2018**

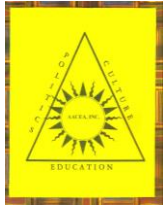
